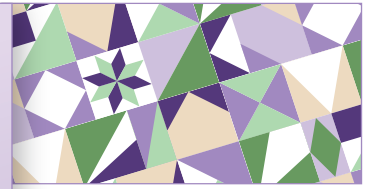

Twisted Pinwheel

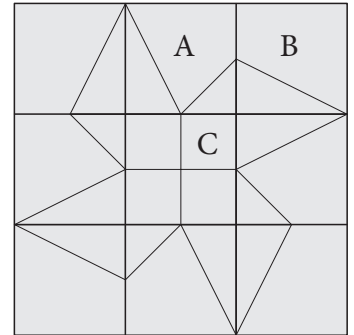

All of the instructions you need to make the units required for this block can be found in the instructions that came with your [V-Block®](#) tool and on the [Sidekick/High Low](#) technique sheet. There are charts, step by step graphics, and directions. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size of the unit you want to make. Then work your way through the instructions.

Once you decide where you are placing your colors in this block you will want to pay attention to the orientation and position of the different units and where the colors need to go within each unit. Pay close attention when cutting each color to be sure you are cutting the correct pieces. When pressing your block I recommend that you press your seams open to help distribute the bulk at some of the seam intersections.



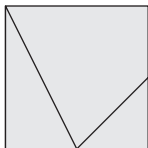

A: High Low Left	4	2" finished unit 2½" cut size	3" finished unit 3½" cut size	4" finished unit 4½" cut size
B: Sidekick Right	4	2" finished unit 2½" cut size	3" finished unit 3½" cut size	4" finished unit 4½" cut size
C: Four Patch	1	1½" sqs. cut size	2" sqs. cut size	2½" sqs. cut size

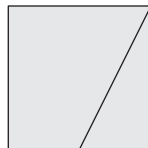
