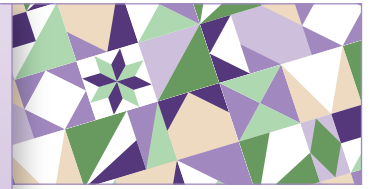

Tucker Trimmer® I, & Square Squared® tools

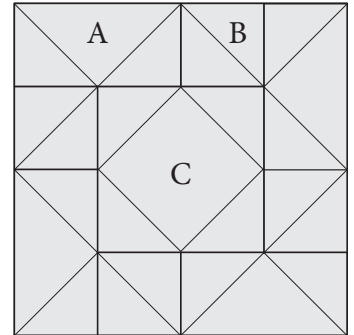

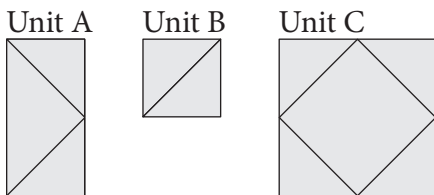

All the instruction you need to make the units required for this block came with your Tucker Trimmer® I, Wing Clipper® and Square Squared® tools. There are charts, step by step graphics, and directions to help you make your units. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size of the unit you want to make, follow it through to find what you need to cut to make those units. Then work your way through the instructions.

Time to make another block that has a partial seam in it. By this time you should be getting pretty good at them. In this block you will assemble the block around the Square Squared® unit that is the center of the block. Your sections in this block will consist of one Flying Goose and one Half Square Triangle; once the units are pieced together you can sew them around the center square like you have done in the past. A tip that will make this block a bit easier to assemble will be to press the seams on your Square Squared unit open. This will help to reduce the bulk at that intersection and make it easier to stitch.

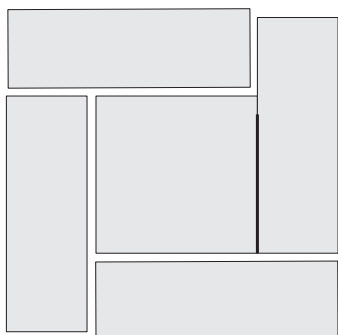

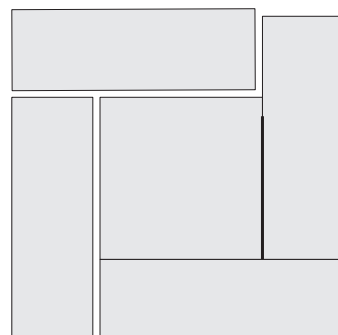


### Block Assembly

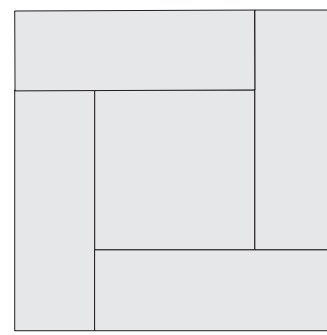
Partial seam, stitch  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  down center square



Stitch along long edge



Repeat and finish partial seam

A: Flying Geese	4	1" x 2" finished size 1½" x 2½" cut size	2" x 4" finished size 2½" x 4½" cut size	3" x 6" finished size 3½" x 6½" cut size
B: Half Square Triangle	4	1" finished size 1½" cut size	2" finished size 2½" cut size	3" finished size 3½" cut size
C: Square Squared	1	2" finished size 2½" cut size	4" finished size 4½" cut size	6" finished size 6½" cut size
