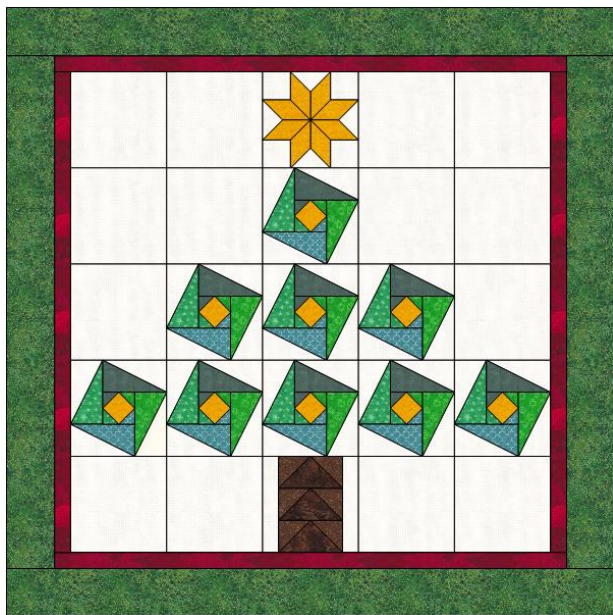


Holiday Topsy Tree, 38" x 38"



Made using Studio 180 Design BlockBuster #27 "Roll the Dice" block pattern and Split Rects, Square Squared, Wing Clipper I & Lemoyne Star tools.

Fabric Requirements:

Fat Eighths:

4 different shades of green for the tree units
2 different shades of brown for the tree trunk.

Scraps: 9 – 2" squares either different or the same for block centers

Lemoyne Star: 1 – 2" strip at least 18" long.

Background: 1 yard

Inner Border: 4 – 1.5" WOF strips.

Outer Border & Binding: ¾ of a yard

Make 36 – 2" x 4" Split Rects: Cut 1 - 5" strip from each of the green fat eighths along the longest edge. Cutting the Rectangles: The split rects should all be either Unit type 1 or unit type 2. I made unit type 2, therefore I placed my strips wrong side up on the cutting mat. For Unit type 1 place your strips right side up on the cutting mat. It doesn't matter which you choose. It just determines which way your block will spin.

Background Fabric: Cut 2 - 5" WOF strips for the Split rects Side triangles. Sub-cut into 36 matching left or right split rects (same as the green Split Rects units).

Color 1: 9 – 2" x 4" split rects

Color 2: 9 – 2" x 4" split rects

Color 3: 9 – 2" x 4" split rects

Color 4: 9 – 2" x 4" split rects

Square/Squared Units: Precision cut the 9 – 2" squares using the square/squared tool.

Make 9 – 2" finished Square/Squared.

Side Triangles: from each of the green fat eighths cut 5 – 2 ¼" squares. Cut once diagonally.

Tree Trunk: From the darker fabric, cut one 5 ½" square and from the lighter fabric cut 4 – 3" squares. Make 3 – 2" x 4" finished flying geese for the trunk

Lemoyne Star: 1 – 6" finished Lemoyne star. Star point fabric cut 1 – 2" strip & star background cut 1 – 3 ¼" strip

Background cut 14 - 6 ½" squares. Cut 2 – 1.5" x 6.5" strips for tree trunk.

Construct following the Studio 180 Design tool instructions.
