## The Hunter Star Petite Class Supply List

The Rapid Fire© Hunter's Star tool and technique allow for streamlined construction and precision trim down and thus results in ease and accuracy when making these traditionally difficult blocks. You have a choice of making the Two, Three or Four Color Quilt Project on page 2 of the tool instructions. For this project we are making 6 " blocks.

## Fabric Requirements for the Two Color Quilt Project:

## $3 / 4$ Yard from Dark Fabrics: PRECUT

- Cut 2 strips 6" x WOF. Cut into 8 squares 6" x6". Then cut once diagonally into 16 half square triangles
- Cut 2 strips $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
- Cut 3 strips $21 / 4 \prime$ x WOF


## $3 / 4$ Yard from Light Fabrics: PRECUT

- Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut into 8 squares $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$. Then cut once diagonally into 16 half square triangles

- Cut 2 strips 1 3/4" x WOF
- Cut 3 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF


## Fabric Requirements for the Three Color Quilt Project:

$1 ⁄ 2$ Yard from Dark Fabrics: PRECUT

- Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut into 8 squares $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ ". Then cut once diagonally into 16 half square triangles
- Cut 2 strips 1 3/4" x WOF


## $1 / 2$ Yard from Light Fabrics: PRECUT

- Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut into 8 squares $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$. Then cut once diagonally into 16 half square triangles
- Cut 2 strips 1 3/4" x WOF

$1 / 2$ Yard from Accent Fabrics - for the Stars/Diamonds
- Cut 6 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ WOF


## Fabric Requirements for the Four Color Quilt Project:

$1 / 2$ Yard from Dark Fabrics: PRECUT

- Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut into 8 squares $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$. Then cut once diagonally into 16 half square triangles
- Cut 2 strips $13 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF
½ Yard from Light Fabrics: PRECUT
- Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut into 8 squares $6^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$. Then cut once diagonally into 16 half square triangles
- Cut 2 strips 1 3/4" x WOF



## $1 / 4$ Yard from Accent Fabrics \#1 - for the Stars/Diamonds

- Cut 3 strips $21 / 4$ " WOF


## $1 / 4$ Yard from Accent Fabric \#2-for the stars/Diamonds

- Cut 3 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ WOF


## Class Supplies:

- Studio 180 Design Hunter Star Petite Tool
- Invisigrip recommended for back of tools.
- 6" x $24^{\prime \prime}$ Ruler for cutting your strips, $6^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ for trimming oversized star points
- Cutting Mat \& Rotary Cutter (with new blade)
- Sewing machine, Thread \& bobbins
- General sewing kit - scissors, pins, seam ripper, machine needles, marking pencil etc.


## Deb's Hint

Make a masking tape guide several layers deep and place it exactly at the 1 3/4" line (for Petite tool) of your ruler. When you bump this raised edge up against the trapezoid/star point unit. It makes the trim down process much more quick.
