Made using Studio 180 Design's Square Squared®, Tucker Trimmer® I, and Corner Pop® Tools and the Triangle Pizazz Technique Sheet

Everything you need to know to make the units required for this block can be found in the instructions that came with Square Squared®, Tucker Trimmer® I, and Corner Pop® tools and on the Triangle Pizazz Technique Sheet. There are charts, step-by-step graphics, and directions. Use the charts to find the information you need for the finished size of the units you want to make; follow it through to find what you need to cut to make those units. Then work your way through the instructions.

When making the Triangle Pizazz units, make sure you pay close attention to the position of the squares so that you make 4 A units. Once you trim the Triangle Pizazz units, you will use them as the base shape and use the Corner Pop® tool to cut away and replace the corner of the large triangle. There are many different ways to color your block, so try playing with color placement to decide how you want your finished block to look.
