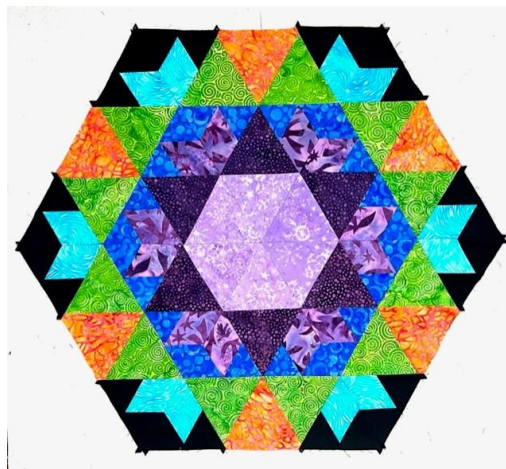


18" Chrysanthemum Block Supply List

3 hour class. Difficulty 2 Stars. This class is also a great introduction to the Star 60 process. This 18" block can look entirely different depending on your fabric choices. Chrysanthemum is made of two sets of 12 Star 60 units, Companion Triangles & Precision Triangles. Our class goal will be to complete one – 18" block. I have given you the fabric requirements for yardage on page 1 and layer cakes on page 2 of this supply list.



Star 60 Units: The Chrysanthemum block can look so different depending on the what colors and how many you choose. In Star Chamber (on the left) I used 4 colors. In the block on the above right I used 8 colors. You can choose to have two different sets of star 60 units, one for the inner ring and one for the outer ring or you can use the same star 60 units in both. If you use fat quarters, double the number of strips, (Just cut the strips, we cut the units in class).

Fabric Requirements for Yardage:

12—3" finished Inner Ring Star 60 Units.

Color 1 – Diamond: cut 1 - 2 ¼" WOF strips.

Color 2 - Side Triangles: cut 2 - 2 ½" WOF strips.

12—3" finished Outer Ring Star 60 Units.

Color 3 – Diamond: cut 1 - 2 ¼" WOF strips.

Color 4 - Side Triangles: cut 2 - 2 ½" WOF strips.

Companion Triangles (Oversized) for Center

Color 5 - Cut one 4" WOF strip in 2 colors Sub-cut 6 oversized triangles

Color 6 - Cut one 4" WOF strip in 2 colors Sub-cut 6 oversized triangles

Companion Triangles (Precision) Outer Ring

Color 7 - Cut one 3 ½" strip. Sub-cut 12 Precision triangles

Color 8 - Cut one 3 ½" strip. Sub-cut 6 Precision triangles

Tools Required: Star 60 tool

InvisiGrip (Recommended)

Mechanical Pencil

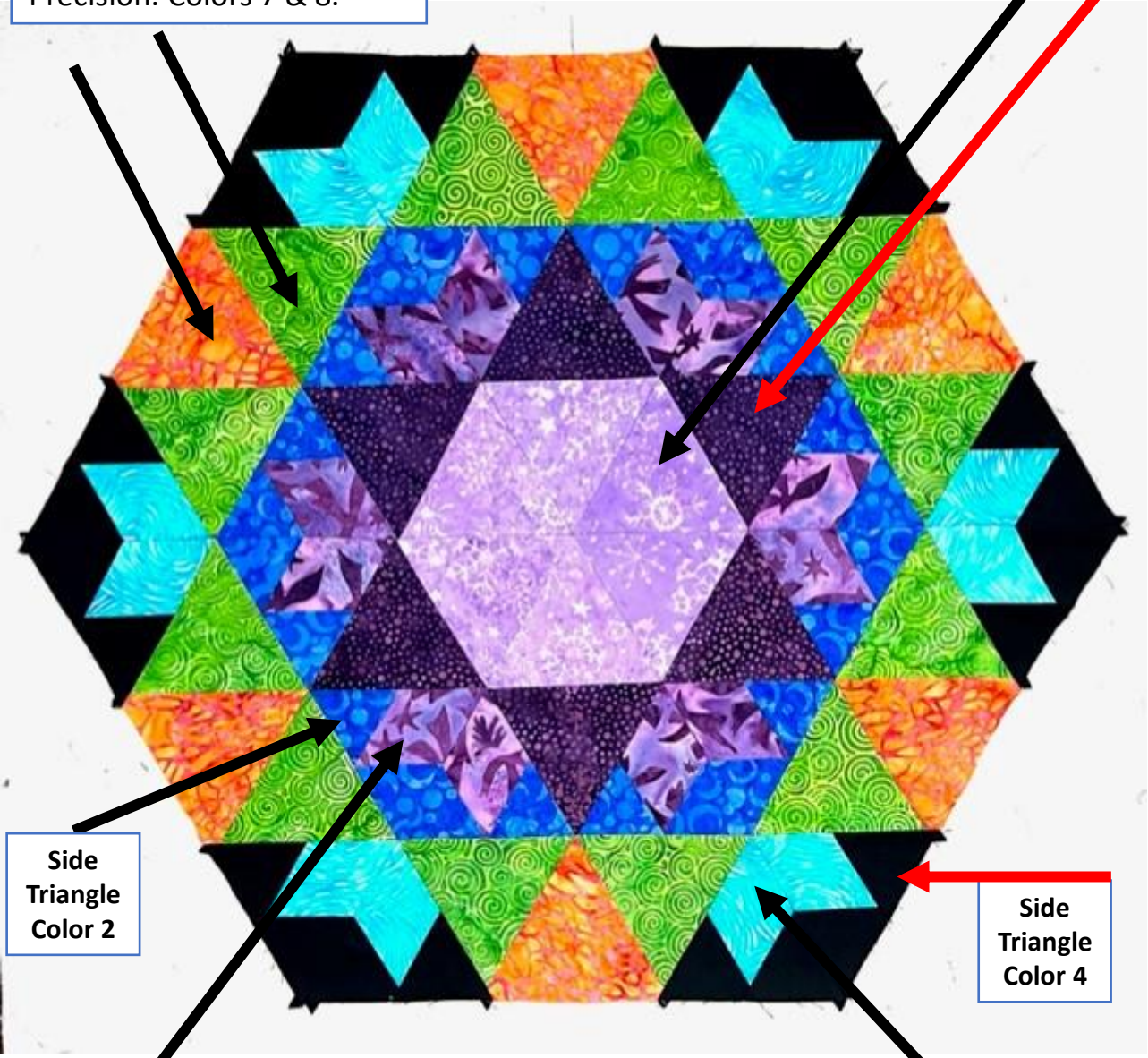
Regular 6" x 12" & 6" x 24" ruler



One Triangle

Companion Triangles Oversized. Colors 5 & 6. You decide which color goes in the middle.

Companion Triangles Precision. Colors 7 & 8.



Side Triangle Color 2

Side Triangle Color 4

Inner Ring of Star 60 Units, The purple **Diamond** is color 1. Side triangle is color 2.

Outer ring of star 60 units. **Diamond** is color 3. Side triangles are color 4. you may use the same color 1 & color 2 for both the inner & outer ring of star 60 units OR use different fabrics as I have done.

OPTIONAL - Chrysanthemum Quilt Using Layer cakes

But wait, there's more! I wanted to see how Chrysanthemum looked in a quilt. I made this version from 10" squares. Each block used 11 – 10" squares. Quilt measures 46" x 60".

Chrysanthemum Quilt Fabric Requirements for 10" squares:

(Cut the Strips only, we will cut the units in class)

Blocks: 66 - 10" squares.

Background: 1 yard

Outer Border & Binding: 1 yard



Each block has 2 sets of 12 – 3" finished Star 60 units.

Diamonds: 2 – 10" squares of the same color per block, to cut 24 diamonds. OR you could use 2 different colors.

Side Triangles: 2 – 10" squares of the same color.

Side Triangles Background: Black was my background I cut 4 – 2.5" WOF strips for the side triangles for 6 blocks (72 sets)



Companion Triangles (Oversized): 4 – 10" squares 2 colors Cut 6 from each color. *One of these triangles will end up in the center of the block. (Make 6)*



Companion Triangles (Precision): 2 – 10" squares same color (cut 12), 1 – 10" square of a different color (make 6).

Setting Pieces

Half Rectangle Triangles: Star 60 instructions, page 11. Cut 1 - 6.5" WOF strip, sub-cut into rectangles 6.5" x 10".
